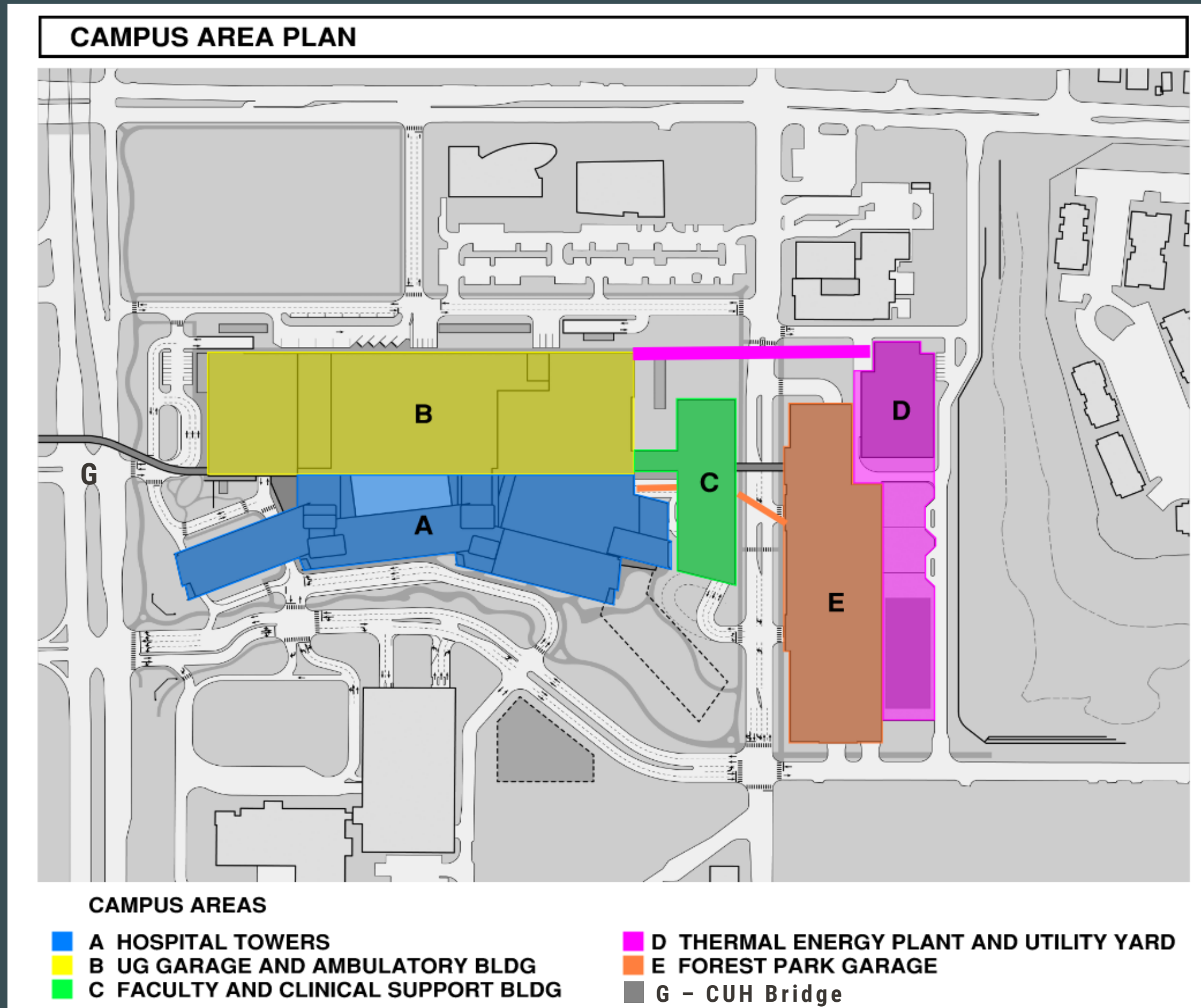

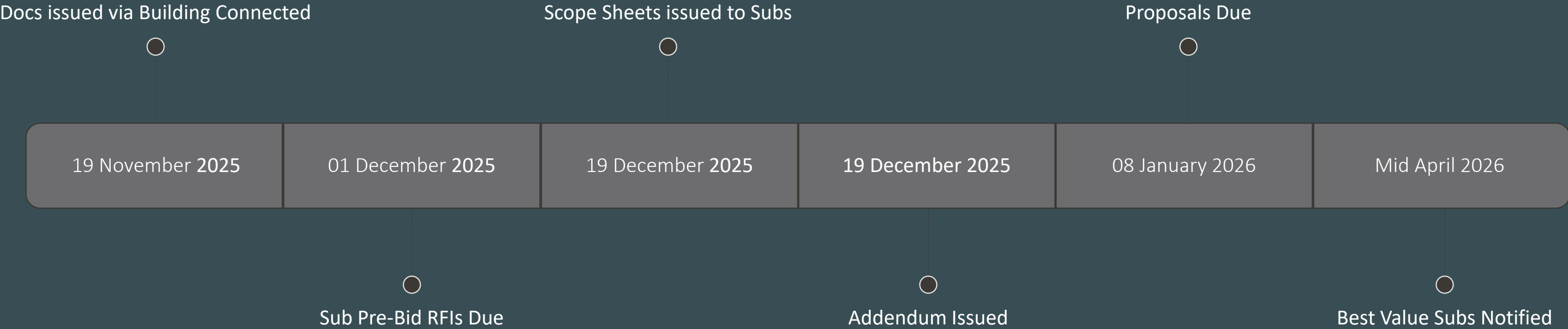

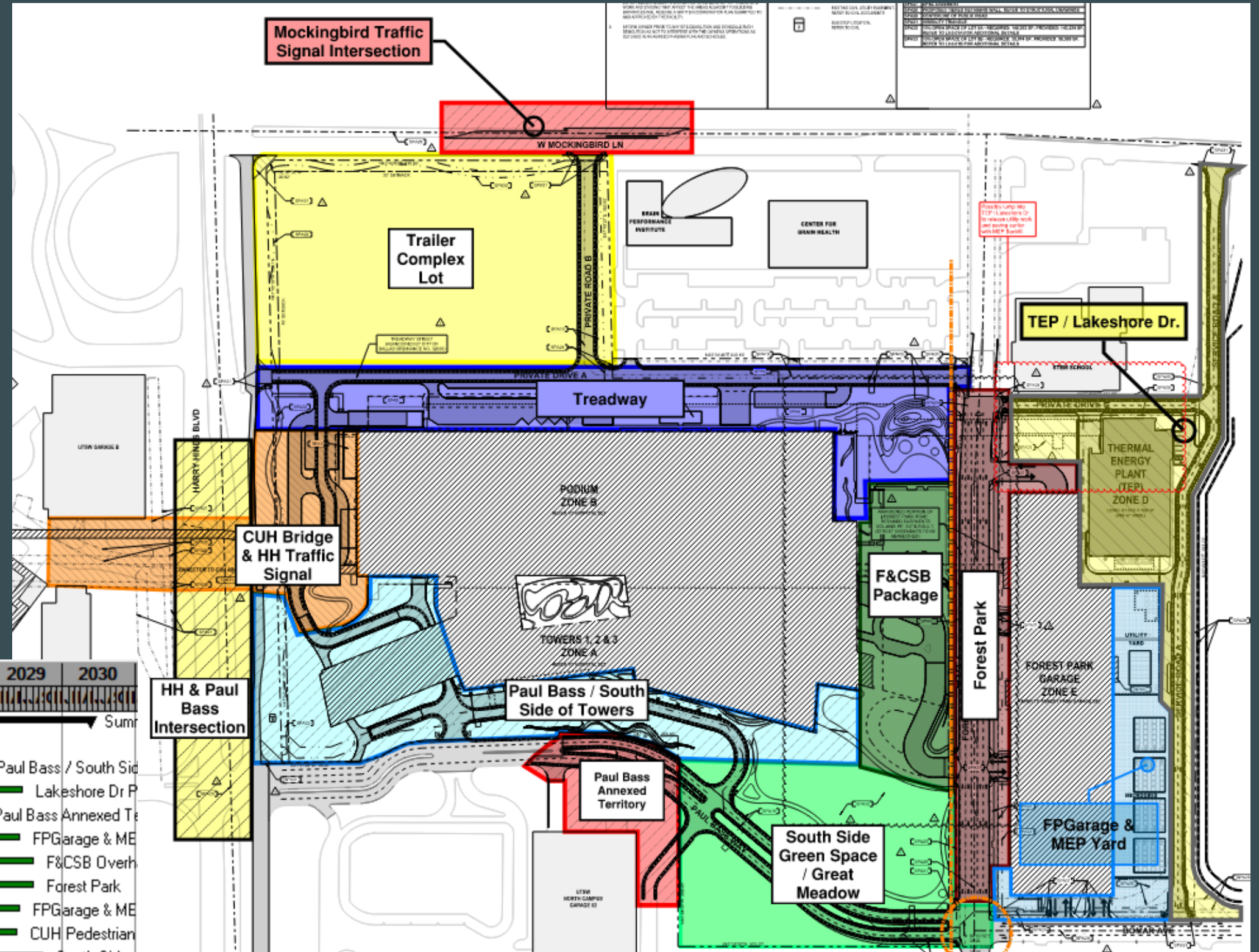

■ DON'T

- Have only one line stating “all xxxx scope”
- Have conflicting inclusions and exclusions
- List exclusions that are not relevant to the project
- Include too many terms and conditions
